TEXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT:

• E.D. Gober informs the Board of Commissioners of Glassboro Housing Authority's early August closing of the Pennrose Project which consists of 65 garden style apartments.

- E.D. Gober indicates Rowan College Special Needs Housing Project submitted application to the Deptford Township Development Review Committee, next step will be to make an application to the Planning Board in October for the 24 special needs units in a three-story midrise building on a plot of land on the RCSJ campus. HAGC Counsel Jeffrey Daniels, Esq. is handling the application, Federici & Akin are the engineer and McKernan is the architect for the project.
- E.D. Gober indicates that HUD has approved the withdraw of the RAD applications for Deptford Park and Carino Park Apartments, HAGC anticipates the needed RAD Physical Assessment that has been previously completed for the RAD conversion will be able to be used once HAGC reapplies.
- E.D. Gober indicates the financial reports are not complete due to the change of date for the Board Meeting but will be distributed to Commissioners once completed.
- E.D. Gober indicates the Audit Exit Conference has been moved to September 14, 2021, at 8:30am.
- E.D. Gober indicates HAGC is working with Gloucester County with the Emergency Rental Assistance, which benefits those behind on rent and/or their utilities. The County may come on site to assist our residents.
- AHO Director Paul Letizia updates the Board of Commissioners on the plank issue at Deptford Park Apartments. The Board of Commissioners previously approved hiring a structural engineer to complete a structural evaluation, The Davinci Group was hired and completed an evaluation of the structural integrity of the building. Prior to The Davinci Group's arrival, HAGC prepped by pulling up the carpet in nine units and exposing the first-floor flooring. The engineering company was looking for any type of settlement between the precast poured cement floor on each floor and the outer wall. They reported there was no deviation from normal structural building standards and no settlement that HAGC needed to be concerned with, the engineer company does not recommend any additional testing and will provide an official report to HAGC, upon receipt the report will be shared with Commissioners.
- Chairman William W. Bain indicates included in the packets is a listing of committee appointments.
- Commissioner Kintzing inquires about the security company and COVID-19 booster vaccines.
