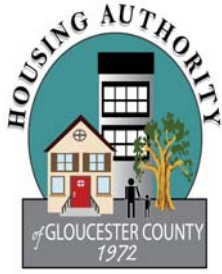
The Secretary notified the Chair that a quorum is present.

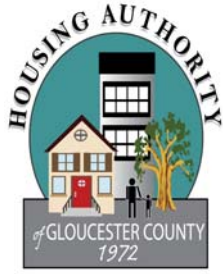

CORRESPONDENCE AND REPORTS:

1. The Senate Appropriations Committee published their Public Housing Bill and they are proposing \$ 4.675 billion to support the operations of Public Housing. This is \$175 million over the 2016 level and \$106 million over the President's proposed budget.
2. Public Housing Capital Fund \$1.92 billion, \$25000 million over the 2016 level.
3. The Senates bill does not eliminate the ROSS Program. HAGC just got our renewal for the ROSS Grant which is \$246,000 over 3 years, July 2016 to June of 2019.
4. The Senate is proposing to expand the RAD program from the current \$185000 CAP up to \$250000 units and to eliminate the September 30, 2016 deadline.

A copy is in the packet, **a copy will be sent electronically to the Board Members.**

5. HUD VASH Vouchers: Executive Director Gober was contacted by HUD and asked if the HAGC would be willing to administer VASH Vouchers for a local office which would be The Philadelphia HUD office. Ms. Gober replied "yes" but subject to the Board's approval.
Jessica Laine, Assistant to Ms. Gober stated after the Board approves the Resolution HAGC will move forward to submitting an application to HUD. The HAGC can then begin meeting with the VA, they would like to go over the process for how HAGC will administer the Vouchers. HAGC and the VA will share in case management, following these individuals so they are an effective participant in our Programs.
Chairman Bain and Commissioner Smith are looking forward to this.
There are 19 Vouchers for Gloucester *and* Camden County.
Commissioner Betty Purnell stated that this is Housing First, getting these applicants housing first and then get them the services they need. Ms. Gober confirmed this.
6. NJHMFA came out to inspect Colonial Park and Nancy Elkis and HAGC received an above average score.
